

It's Sunday in KZ. And while you are worshipping at the Christian Life Center, your kids are doing the same—their way! **KZ** is a Christ-centered place with a kid-friendly philosophy. It's a completely active and interactive experience. We want kids to feel comfortable and to know that they can come to Christ just as they are.



Kindergarteners through 5th Graders get underway in the **KZ** auditorium with worship — which means a lot of singing and moving!

After releasing some energy, we touch on the lesson. Games, video, skits or object lessons are used to introduce the Bible Story and the Bible Point for that week. Then it's on to reinforce the Memory Verse, with a game or just reciting the verse. Large Group time closes with prayer, followed by the collection of the tithe and offering.

By then, 20 minutes are gone and the kids move into their classrooms for an in-depth exploration of the Bible Story, the Bible Point, and scripture. Before we know it, time is up and parents return to gather their kids!



Special events are a big part of KZ.

- ▶ The first Sunday of the month is **Birthday Sunday**. The last Sunday of the month is **Scripture Sunday**.
- ▶ **Fourth Sunday** lessons are taught in a Large Group format in the auditorium. It's a very active lesson with lots of games and fun! For months with a **Fifth Sunday**, we also follow this format.
- ▶ Flyers and letters are sent home to keep you informed of other special events, such as **Mission Month** and **Parent Month**.

Pre-schoolers ages 2, 3, and 4 have the same **KZ** experience as the older kids within the safe, familiar environment of their classrooms.
